Though it would unsettle the House leadership situation, the appointment of Carl^x Albert to the Court would be hailed in Congress, and give the Court a Rhodes-scholar lawyer with a superb judicial temperament.

Other possibilities, by free association: Hugh^x Cox, for sheer intellectual brilliance and character, without raising political problems (also without producing immediate political support, though the ABA would certainly rank him among the best qualified lawyers in the country).
