LEGISLATION TO ESTABLISH AN INDEPENDENT FAA

Later this week or early next week, Senator Ford intends to introduce legislation to establish the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as an independent agency. Then, on September 10, he will chair an Aviation Subcommittee hearing on the idea of separating the FAA from the Department of Transportation (DOT).

Since becoming Chairman of the Aviation Subcommittee, Senator Ford has become increasingly concerned about the level of interference in the FAA's aviation safety efforts by the Secretary and her staff. At a speech in Washington earlier this year, he mentioned the idea of creating an independent FAA and it got very strong support from the majority of the aviation groups.
