Sec. 4018, Modified - Authorizes appropriations for a Commerce Department program relating to waterfront communities.

Sec. 4019- Directs the Corps to revise the Table Rock Master Plan for Table Rock Lake, Arkansas and Missouri

Sec. 4020- Expedites a decision for the project for flood damage reduction in the Pearl River Basin

Sec. 5002(e)- Authorizes the prepayment of contracts between the United States and the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District in Utah.

Sec. 5002(f)- Deauthorizes a navigation project on the Essex River, Massachusetts

Sec. 5002(g)- Deauthorizes Hannibal Small Harbor

Sec. 6001(1)(9)- Authorizes a Chief's Report for the Upper Ohio River Navigation Project, PA

Sec. 6004(4)- Expedites a deepening study for Mobile Harbor

Sec. 6004(3)- Expedites a report for Hudson-Raritan Estuary Comprehensive Restoration Project

Sec. 6006- Requires a GAO study on the methodology and performance metrics used to calculate costbenefit ratios and evaluate construction projects and impacts on small and rural communities.

Sec. 6007- Require the Secretary to complete a Corps asset inventory required under the WRRDA 2014

Sec. 6009- Clarifies the existing authority for sediment reduction and erosion control in the Yazoo Basin

Title VII(f)(5)- Authorizes a restoration program for the Columbia River.

Title VII(g)- Establishes a water infrastructure workforce investment grant program

Sec. 7206- Authorizes appropriations for EPA to carry out a Chesapeake Bay Grass Survey.

Sec. 7207- Establishes of a Great Lakes Algal Bloom Coordinator.

Sec. 7302, Modified- Modifies the selection criteria for certain WIFIA projects to include considerations for project resiliency

Sec. 7304, Modified - Adds new eligibilities to the Innovative Water Technology Grant Program

Sec. 7307, Modified- Clarifies which agencies are responsible for developing nonregulatory national drought resilience guidelines and incorporates ongoing Federal drought resiliency efforts.

Sec. 7612- Reauthorizes the Great Lakes Fish and Wildlife Restoration Act

Sec. 8003- Authorizes a land transfer to the Muscogee (Creek) Nation, OK

Sec. 8004- Reauthorizes the Denali Commission

Sec. 8005- Ensures continued recreational access for floating cabins on the TVA system
