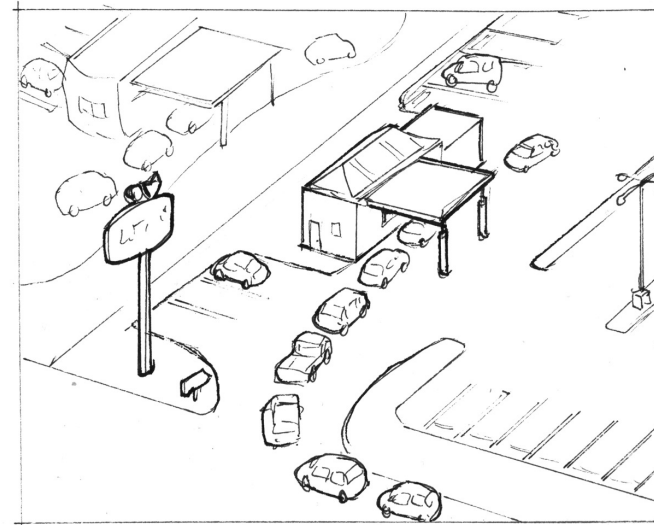

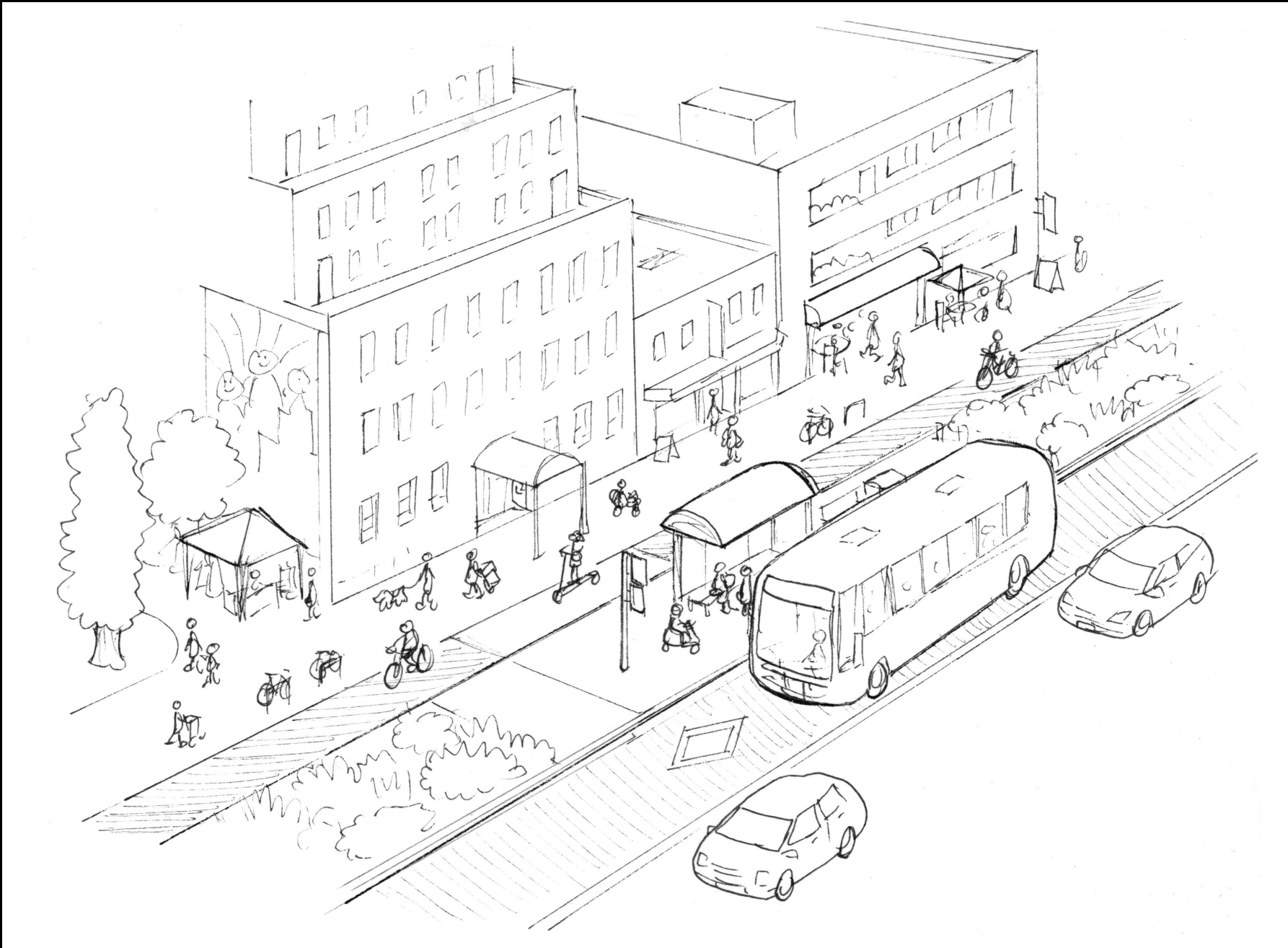


A rendering of Pine Street Inn's project at 3368 Washington St. in Jamaica Plain.

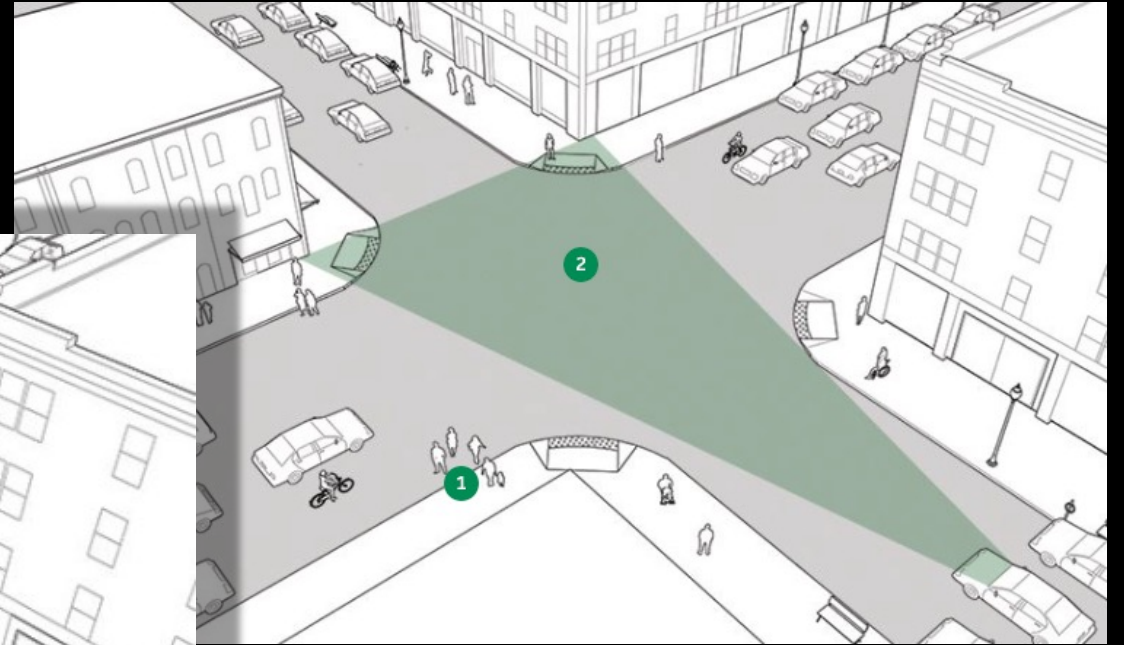
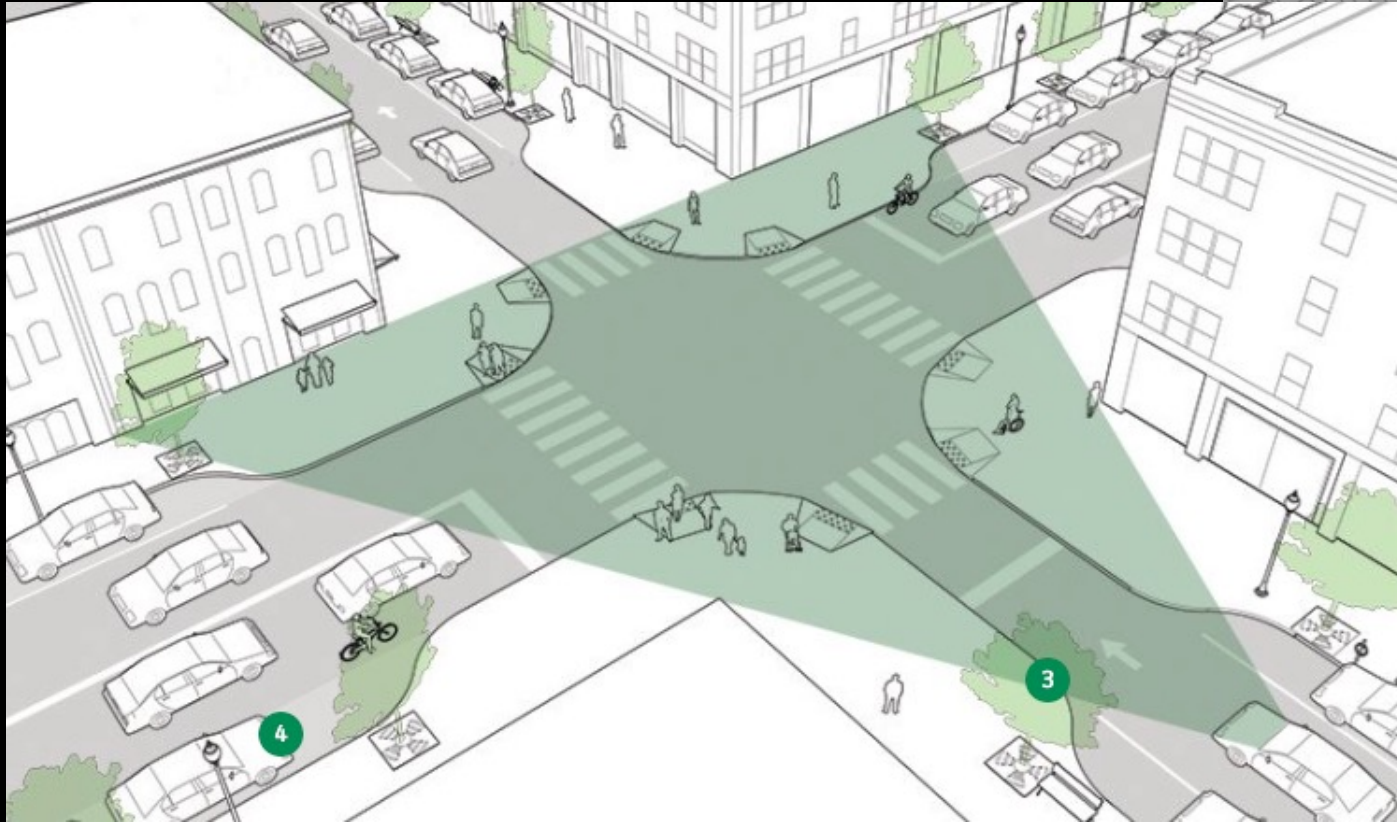
